- Board of Zoning Appeals** - Reviews variances and special exceptions of the City Zoning Code, along with claims of administrative error in the interpretation of the Zoning Code. Consists of three members and one alternate member appointed to staggered three-year terms.
- Economic Development Commission** - Makes recommendations to the Mayor and Council of measures to enhance the economic well-being of the community, along with planning and executing various activities and educational events to further that goal. Consists of not more than seven members appointed to four-year terms.
- Equity and Inclusion Task Force** – Develops an action plan for ensuring the work of City government is equitable and inclusive for all including commission/committee membership, public meetings and events, and community overall are representative of diversity. Members serve two-year terms.
- Ethics Commission** - Tasked with administering the City Ethics Ordinance, which sets minimum standards of Ethical Conduct for City officials and employees, so as to ensure City business is conducted impartially and not subject to improper influences. Consists of three to five members appointed to staggered three-year terms.
- Finance and Utility Commission** - Advises and makes recommendations to the Mayor and Council in matters pertaining to financial and utility activities. Consists of up to five citizen members appointed to four-year terms.
- History Commission** - Collects, organizes, and preserves records of local historical significance, and makes recommendations to the Mayor and Council on matters relating to the history of Brunswick. Consists of not more than seven members appointed to four-year terms.
- Parks & Recreation Committee** – Advises the Mayor and Council of improvements to the City's park system and recreational activities. Consists of not more than seven members appointed to four-year terms.
- Planning Commission** - Reviews and analyzes all planning and zoning proposals for the City and makes recommendations for goals and objectives for the City's Master Plan to the Mayor and Council. Consists of five members and one alternate member appointed to staggered five-year terms.
