

Brunswick History Commission Meeting Minutes

Thursday, November 13, 2025, at 2:00pm

The following topics were discussed:

- Business:
 - Historical Timeline:
 - Tad Achey presented a sample of a section of the Timeline that he has worked on, explaining that this is just an early draft. The paragraphs have a larger font. It was favorable to all present.
 - Motion made and approved unanimously to have Tad move ahead with the design of the Timeline.
 - Wayne will provide files of pictures and verbiage to Tad.
 - Work that still needs to be done: Add 1963 Little League Baseball Team's trip to the World Series in 1963; Wayne will work with Tad on improving maps and graphs.
 - Tad also presented options for the actual display: (1) A vinyl banner can be produced for \$350; stand would be in addition. (2) A display on fabric, pulled over a frame, would cost \$1,000. This decision will be made later.
 - Quarterly Business meeting will be postponed from December 11 to December 18.
- History Discussion:
 - Dave reviewed his 16-foot 1920 Brunswick rail yard display with Paula.
 - Wayne told about his hike to the ruins of Weverton earlier this week and led a short discussion on the history of that short-lived industrial community.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:15 pm (without a single interruption by passing trains, for the second week in a row!)
